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1. NEED FOR AND IMPORTANCE OF THIS COURSE

Educational research is a systematic attempt to get a better understanding of the educational process, with a view to improving its efficiency and quality. Educational research is an application of the scientific method, which involves the study of educational problems. The spread of educational research is quite broad - philosophy of teaching, educational psychology, pedagogy, policy, assessment, teaching strategies, classroom management and organization, and development are some of the important areas of research in Secondary Teacher Education.

In the present scenario, the role of a secondary school teacher as a researcher has been accredited. Education is considered a science with a distinct body of knowledge. Educational development is dependent upon the creation of new knowledge, so there is a need to explore new dimensions of knowledge to bring about improvement in the field of education. The acquisition of scientific knowledge requires innovative ways of teaching, learning, assessment, evaluation and others. In the field of education, with every passing day, new problems, issues and trends are emerging. Now is the time to resolve these issues and solve the problems of education through empirical research. This is the era of knowledge explosion and with it, the concepts of education are changing that demand scientific research. The past two decades have experienced great changes as a result of rapid scientific and technological development. Education has to play a pivotal role in the smooth acceptance of change by the masses. The process of rapid change is accompanied by problems which are evident in the area of teacher education. This capstone project is a hands-on practice for students to apply the scientific method and solve educational problems.

2. COURSE DESCRIPTION

The purpose of the capstone project Code (8342) is to engage prospective teachers who are enrolled in B.Ed 4 years program in the research process. A capstone project helps them to understand a particular problem or phenomenon, along with strengthening their comprehension of the research process. They get the first-hand knowledge about:

- (a) how the steps of the research process are interlinked,
- (b) developing an understanding and appreciation of how knowledge evolves, and
- (c) contributing to the existing body of knowledge.
- (d) applying research knowledge in problem-solving and real-life situations.

It is a common perception that teacher education in Pakistan lacks practical research work, and more focus is on theoretical knowledge. No doubt, theoretical knowledge should be linked with classroom practices to make the teacher education programs more effective. The role of teacher as a researcher is being accentuated to find the solution to daily problems. The Higher Education Commission of Pakistan suggested some radical changes in the teacher education programs. To incorporate the suggestions of the HEC, Allama Iqbal Open University has decided to equip its prospective teachers with skills-based practical work under the supervision of experienced and highly qualified teachers. A research project is one of such offerings to the students, which will provide them with some basic skills for being an effective teacher. It is designed to provide them with a critical approach, scientific attitude and reflective thinking. In the previous semesters, the students were offered 'Educational Research & Statistics', and 'Teaching Practice'. The experiences from these courses will help the students build the narrative and

complete the research project. Keeping in view the importance of research in the professional life of teachers, universities of developed countries have made research an imperative part of teacher education programs. To set a higher quality of pre-service teacher education in Pakistan, Allama Iqbal Open University has also made it mandatory for B.Ed students to conduct research and write a report.

We have already learnt that research is a way of solving educational problems by adopting the scientific method. It provides prompt solutions that are valid and reliable. Basically, research is conducted to identify the problems related to the field of secondary education. Nowadays, adolescents are mostly enrolled in secondary classes; the nature of problems is diverse at this stage. So, being skilled in conducting research is important for becoming an effective teacher.

3. PURPOSE OF THE CAPSTONE PROJECT

A capstone project is a culminating assignment that students typically complete at the end of an academic program, such as in high school, college, or graduate school. It is designed to encourage students to use the knowledge and skills they've gained throughout their studies to solve a real-world problem or complete a comprehensive research or practical project. A capstone project is a multifaceted, final assignment that serves as a student's academic and intellectual experience "capstone" or crowning achievement. It often involves research, problem-solving, critical thinking, and communication skills.

The purposes of the capstone project are as follows:

- To engage prospective teachers in research by following all steps of scientific research and enabling them to develop a research report.
- To synthesize learning from multiple courses or subjects.
- To demonstrate mastery of key concepts and skills.
- To apply knowledge to a real-world issue or project.
- To prepare for professional work or further academic study.

4. COURSE LEARNING OUTCOMES

Prospective teachers will be able to:

- identify the importance of scientific research.
- identify educational problems related to the teaching and learning process at the secondary level.
- describe the variables involved in the research.
- develop a scientific plan to solve the problem.
- review the related literature to know how others solved similar problems.
- review the literature to find the gap for the problem under study.
- identify the research methodology according to the nature of the study.
- develop research instrument(s) i.e. questionnaire, observation, interview etc.
- administer the research instruments to gather data.
- analyze the obtained data qualitatively or quantitatively.
- draw conclusions based on the analysis of data.
- write a summary of the research procedure.
- develop a research report according to APA style.
- format the research report according to the guidelines of the APA manual.
- format the research report according to the guidelines of the APA manual.

5. COURSE STRUCTURE

This course is a compulsory component of the B.Ed. 4-year Specialization in Secondary Teacher Education. This course comprises three credit hours. It is of a practical nature based on field work. The following components will determine the structure of the capstone project code 8342 B.Ed 4-Year.

- 1. The Capstone Project shall carry three credits.
- 2. Six days workshop shall be arranged by the University to understand the procedure of the capstone project.
- 3. Four out of six days of attendance in the workshop is mandatory for all the students.
- 4. The resource person for the workshop will be the supervisor of that research group. The student shall work under the guidance of the supervisor from the workshop till the submission of the capstone project.
- 5. The student shall finalize the topic and submit/upload one one-page proposal to the supervisor, preferably within 15 days after the workshop, for approval.

The proposal must comprise:

- Student's details (Name, Father's name, ID, Email, Phone number, Semester, Program, Supervisor)
- Topic/ Title of the Capstone Project
- Objectives
- Research Questions/Hypotheses
- Brief description about population, sample and research tool/s.
- 6. The format for the capstone project will be according to the approved guidelines by the university.
- 7. The Supervisor will be expected to:
- Guide in designing and co-coordinating the project.
- Approval of the topic in light of a one-page proposal submitted by the student.
- Monitor students' progress throughout the stipulated research period by the university.
- Check and provide feedback for improvement in drafts of the project.
- The supervisor will maintain the progress report according to the documents received, reviewed and signed by each student.
- Before the final submission, the student will present the research online and upload the same on his/her LMS portal (according to the schedule) to the supervisor, who will grade this component.
- After the presentation, all students will be given 10 days' time for improvement/revision before uploading on LMS with the consent of the supervisor for external evaluation.
- 8. The maximum period for completing the capstone project shall be four months.
- 9. The student will be required to maintain progress under the guidance of the supervisor throughout the period of research work, beginning with the workshop, one-page proposal, approval of the topic, and presentation till the final submission.
- 10. On completion of the research, the student will submit/upload a typed/ composed copy of the project on the LMS portal.
- 11. The LMS portal will be active for the capstone project submission only for those students who have qualified for the attendance criteria given in Sr No 3.
- 12. The student will be required to abide by the format and style as specified below:

- Titles of the research, font style Times New Roman, Size 14 and Bold
- Section headings, font style Times New Roman, Size 12 and Bold
- Questions under each section, font style Times New Roman, Size 12 and Bold
- Any other subheadings should be presented in order according to the related question. Example: For answering question 1, the subheadings may proceed as 1.1, 1.2, 1.3 and so on.
- Page size A-4 with 1-inch margins on all 4 sides.
- Page number should be inserted at the bottom in the middle of the page.
- Tables and figures should have proper titles and numbers as per APA format.
- The research manual will be evaluated based on quality of work and marks will be awarded according to the marking scheme/ marks mentioned in each section of the manual.
- The research report will be written only in the English language. Languages other than English will not be accepted.
- Capstone Projects will not be evaluated by the same supervisors.
- Resource persons or Coordinators may supervise the students. The coordinators'/ resource persons' qualifications should be the same as those of the supervisor.
- Workshop or project work may be monitored by the Department of Secondary Teacher Education, Allama Iqbal Open University.

Who can supervise, coordinate, or teach?

The prospective teachers will complete the Capstone Project under the guidance of a supervisor. Supervisors may be people who are coordinating the workshop or acting as a resource person. It will be mandatory that the supervisor has at least an MS/M.Phil's degree in Education.

6. TEACHING -LEARNING METHODOLOGY

The Capstone project is different from the development of a lesson plan and teaching practice. The Capstone Project is an activity-based course with a focus on the development of research skills. Mostly scientific research develops skills like identification of problems, posing questions, gathering data, interpretation of data, reflecting on the data, interpretation and decision making for suggesting the solution of the problem. Teaching —learning methodology includes workshops, field work, meetings with supervisors and an evaluation process.

Selection of the Topic

The students will be given the liberty to choose any area of interest from the field of education, specially focusing on Secondary Teacher Education. The topics will be decided in consultation with the resource persons/supervisors during the workshop.
